

HOW MUCH URIDE DRIVERS MAKE



Average trip distance for rideshare in North America is 9.5km, we used a more modest 6.5km to compensate for URides small city focus.

AVERAGE FARE FOR 6.5KM TRIP

We found out what it costs for a 6.5km trip in each of the cities URide operates in. Then we used the average of those fares to estimate how much a 6.5km trip might cost a URide rider.

HOW MUCH OF THE FARE DOES A DRIVER GET?

URide says that drivers usually earn about 70%-75% of the trip fare. We went with 70% just to estimate the worst case scenario.

WHAT A \$150 DAY LOOKS LIKE

To make \$150 a day you would need to make 13 of our average trips over the day. If you work an 8 hour day you would do 1.6 trips per hour.

WHAT A \$300 DAY LOOKS LIKE

To make \$300 a day you would need to make 26 of our average trips over the day. If you work an 8 hour day you would need to do 3.25 trips per hour

SALARY EQUIVALENTS

If you make \$150/day consistently, you would make around \$39,000/year. If you make \$300/day consistently, you would make around \$78,000/year.
